PREFACE

The Saint Mary's University Fact Book is a compilation of historical and current data designed to facilitate internal communication, provide data to use in decision making, planning and improvement efforts, and answer frequently asked questions about the university. The SMU Fact Book is compiled and maintained by the Office of Institutional Research. Requests for additional or more detailed information are always welcome and should be directed to Kara Wener, Institutional Researcher.

Data are presented in varying time frames often following mandatory federal reporting guidelines; notes on data time frames may be found in the tables' footnotes. The SMU Fact Book is presented in six chapters: academic profile, enrollment profile, student profile, faculty and staff profile, financial data, and Nairobi campus and Jamaica data. Throughout the SMU Fact Book, data is often presented in terms of the university's two primary academic units: the College and the Schools of Graduate and Professional Programs (SGPP). The College consists of the traditional undergraduate Bachelor of Arts program based on the Winona campus. The SGPP includes continuing education courses, certificate programs at the undergraduate and graduate levels, the Bachelor of Science completion program, master's programs, the Education Specialist program, the Doctor of Education in Leadership and Doctor of Psychology in Counseling Psychology. The SGPP are based on both the Twin Cities and Winona campuses, with centers in Rochester, Apple Valley, Minnetonka and Oakdale, MN. Also of note, data from the Nairobi campus and the Master of Education in Teaching and Learning program offered in Mandeville, Jamaica appear separately and are presented in the chapter entitled Nairobi campus and Jamaica data.

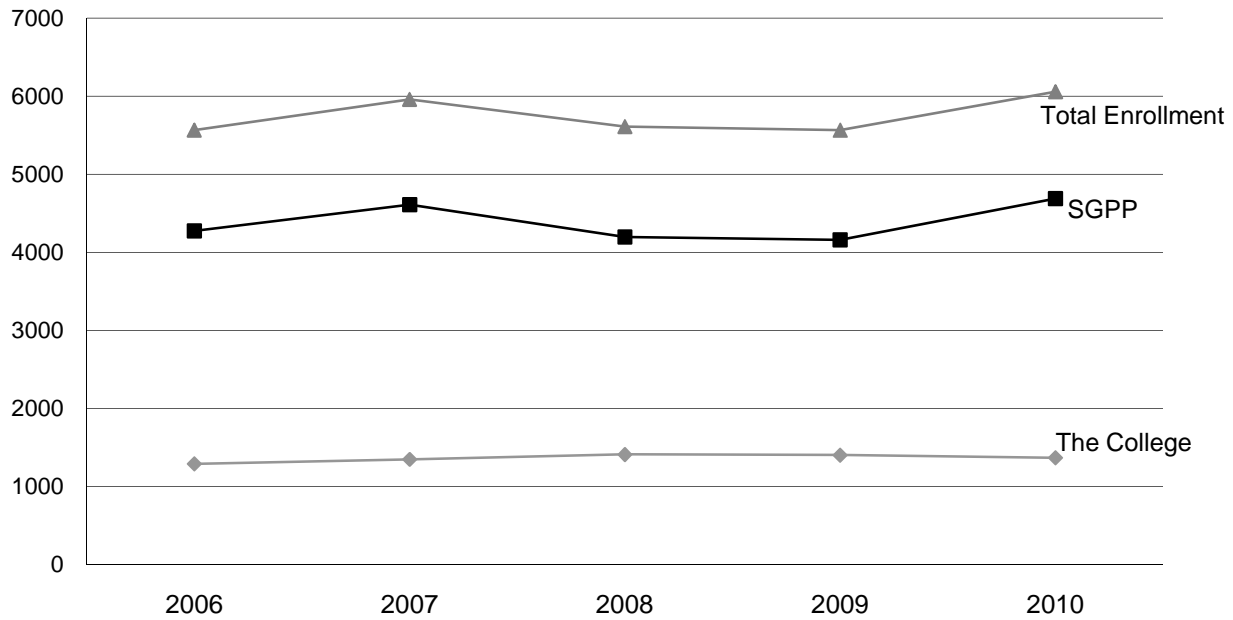

Total Headcount Enrollment Fall 2006 to Fall 2010

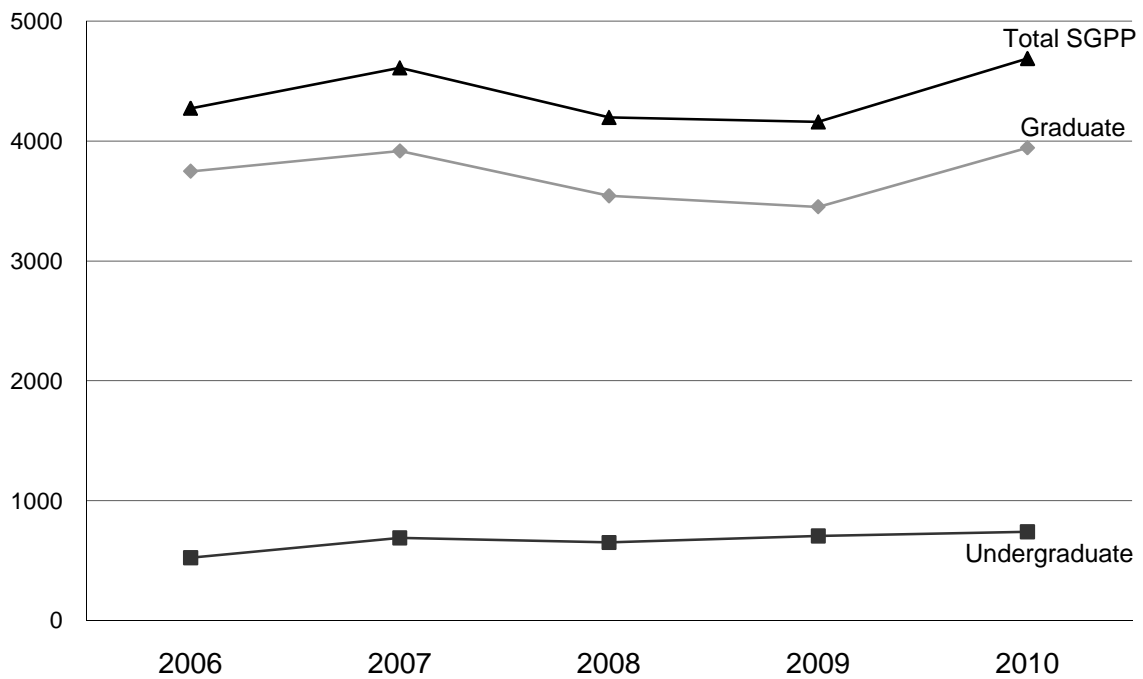

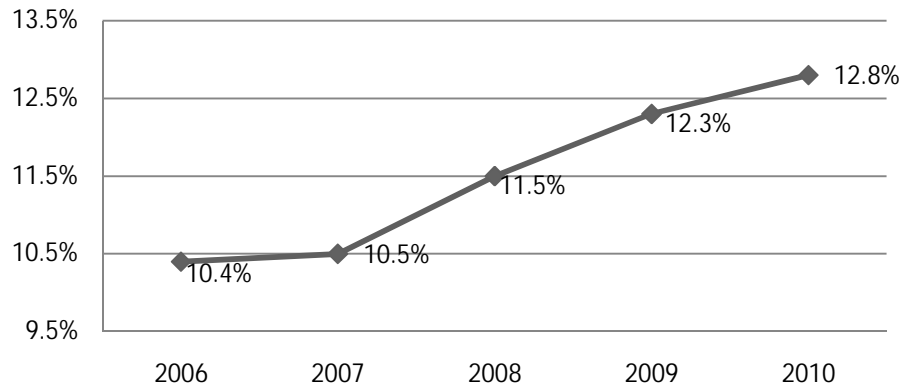
SGPP Total Headcount Enrollment Fall 2006 to Fall 2010



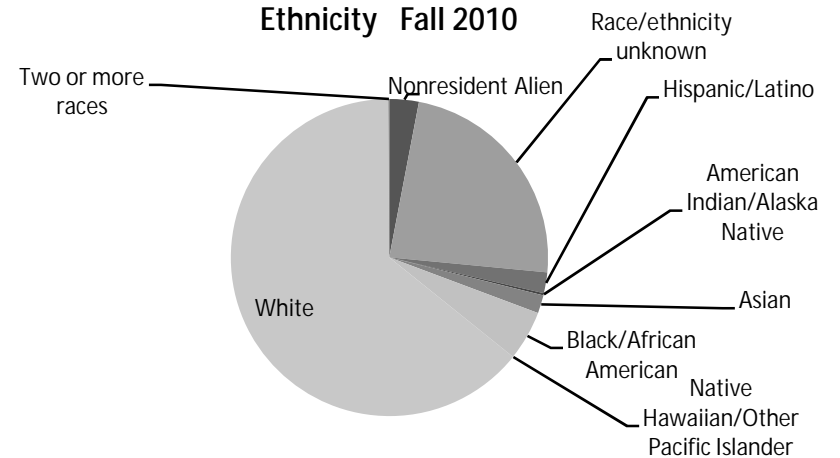

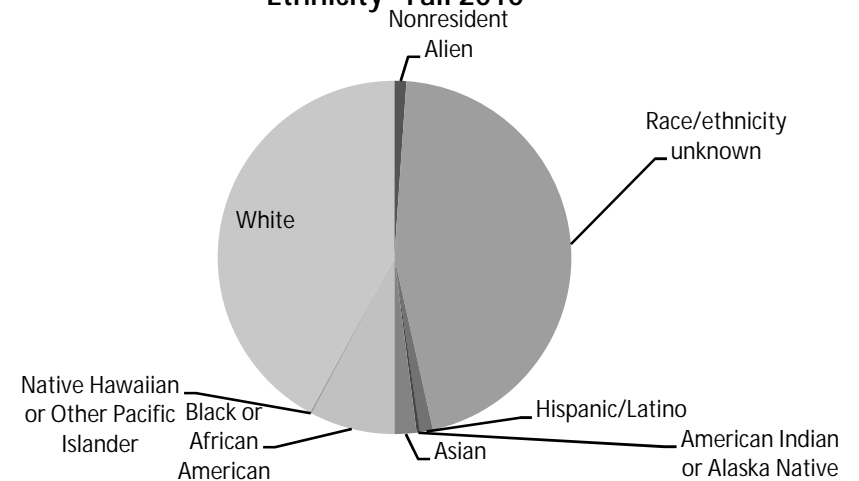

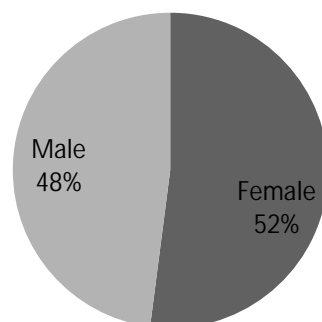

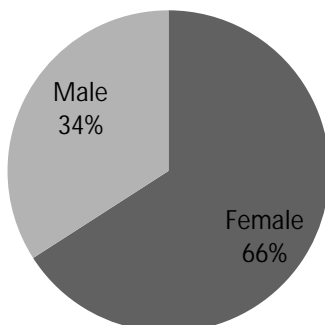
University wide Enrollment by Gender

Fall 2010



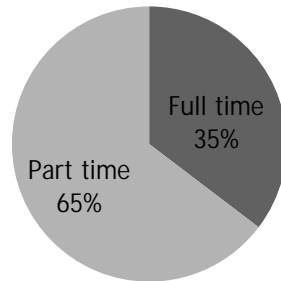
SGPP Enrollment by Gender

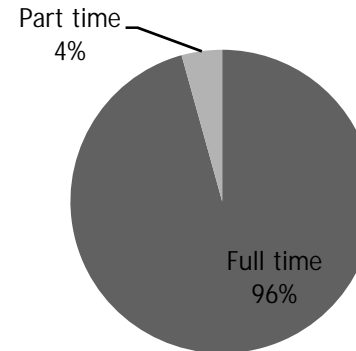

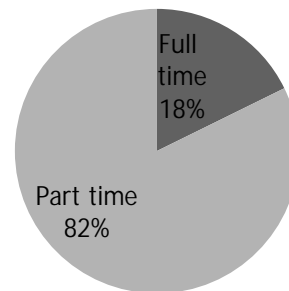
University wide Enrollment by Status

SGPP Enrollment by Status Fall 2010

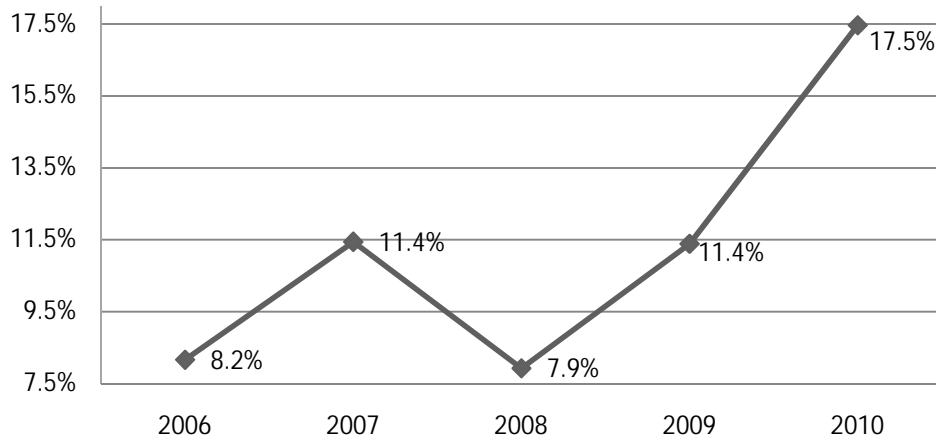

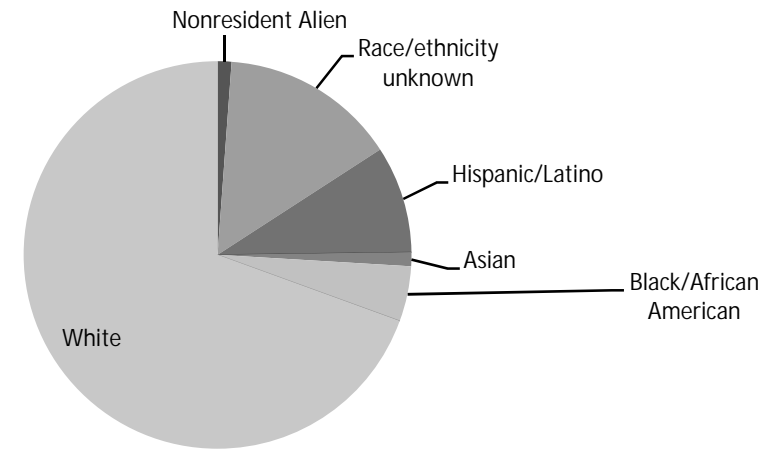

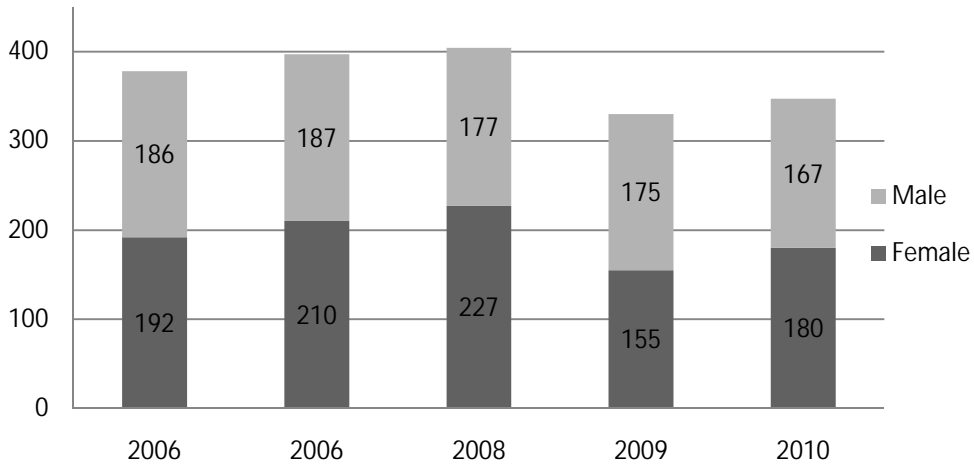

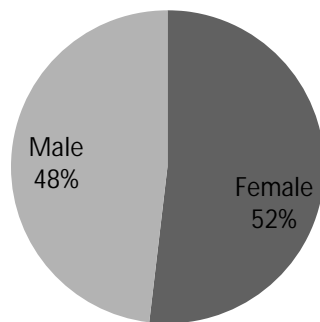

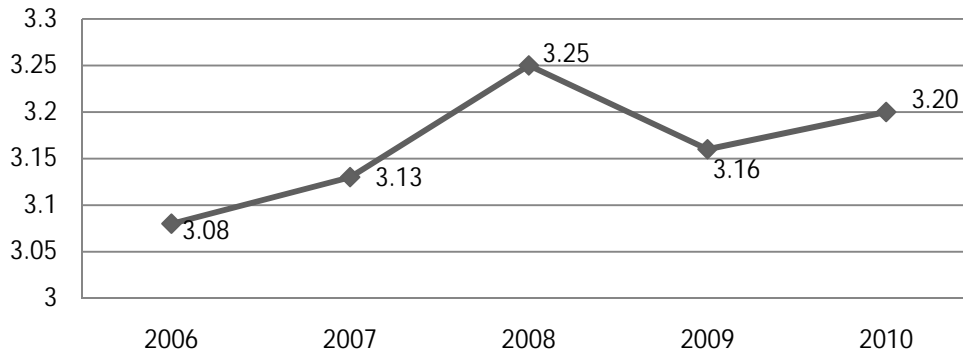

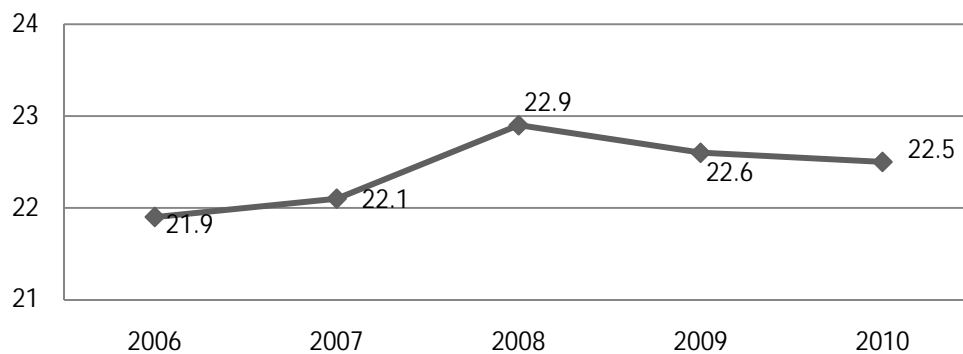

Average High School GPA

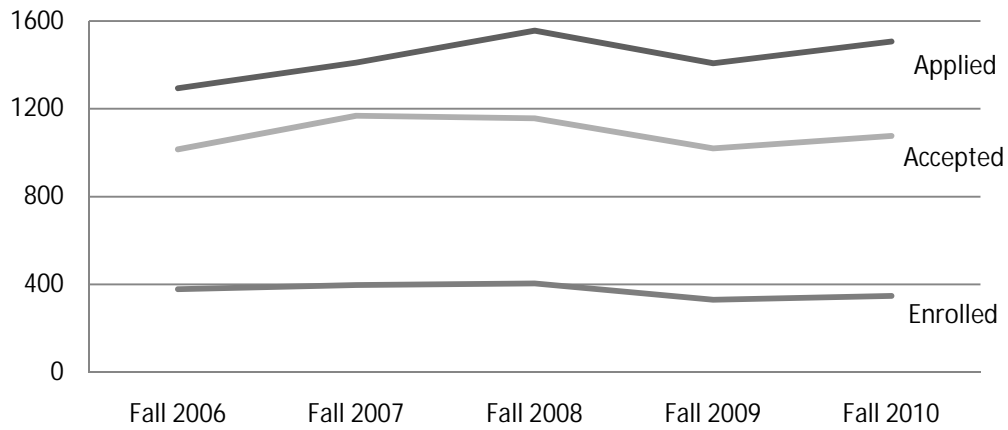


Average Composite ACT Score

Headcount of First time, First year, Full time Students by Admission Status

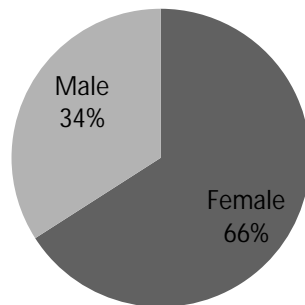

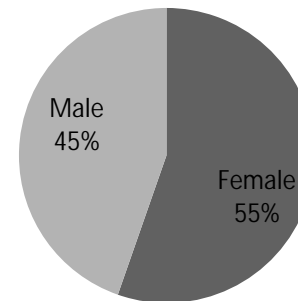

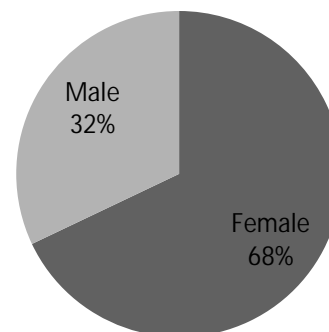
SGPP Enrollment by Gender Fall 2010



SGPP Undergraduate Enrollment by Gender Fall 2010



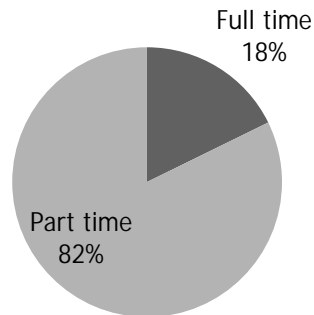
SGPP Graduate Enrollment by Gender Fall 2010



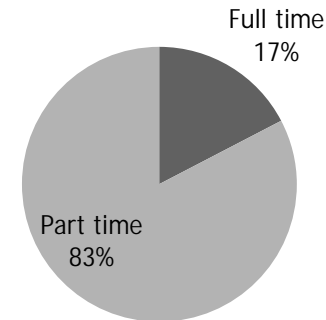

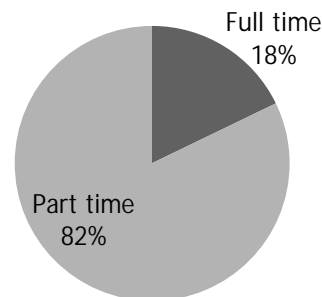
**Total SGPP by Time Status

Fall 2010**

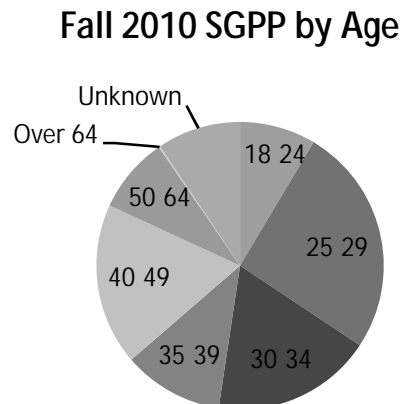
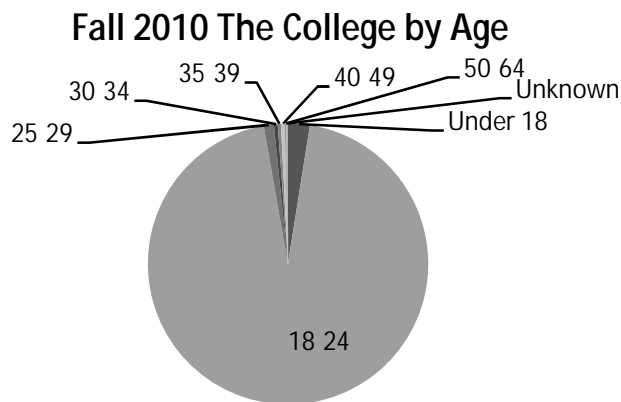


**SGPP Graduate by Time Status

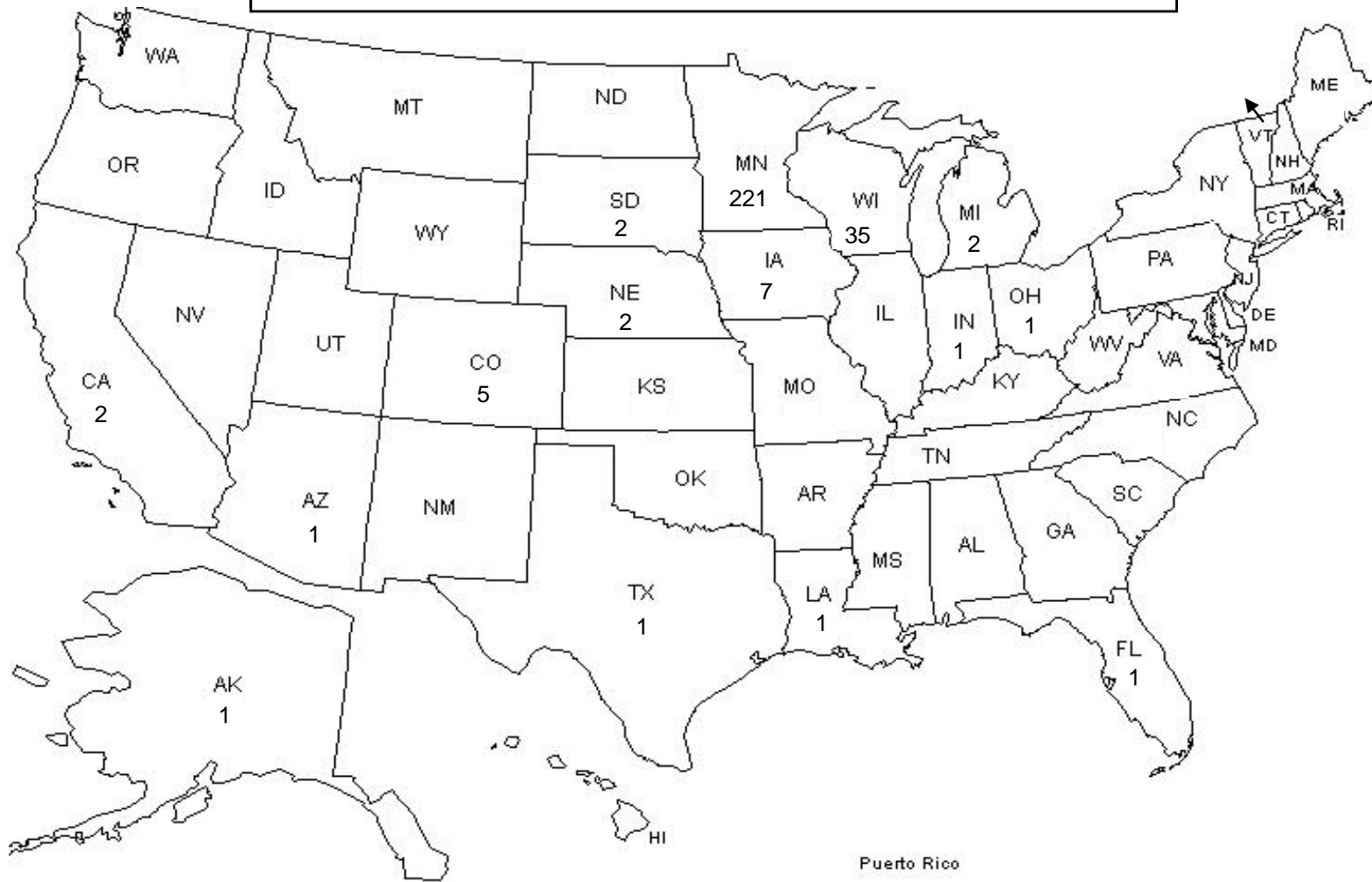

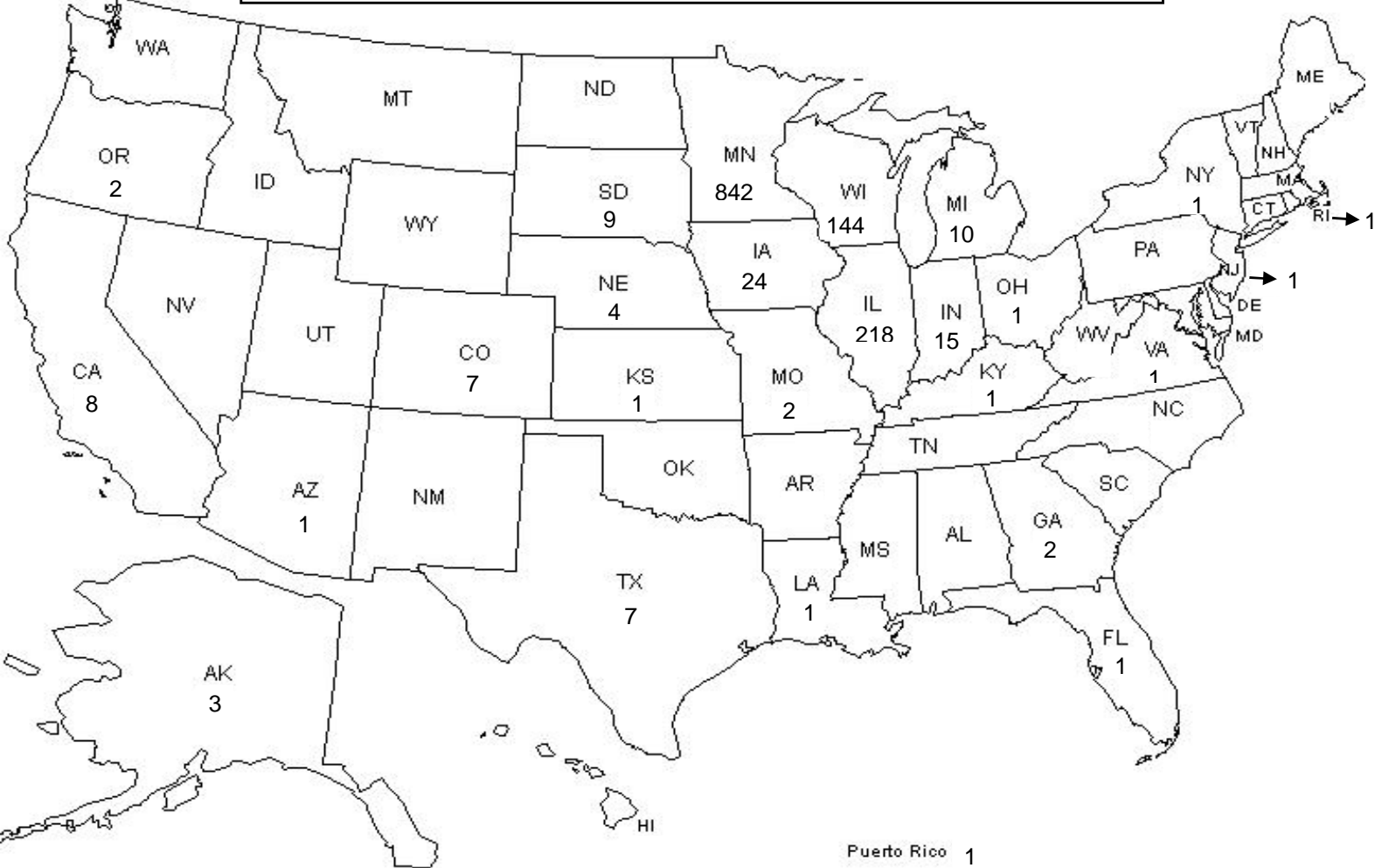

Saint Mary's University of Minnesota - The College First-time, First-year Students from each State, Fall 2010



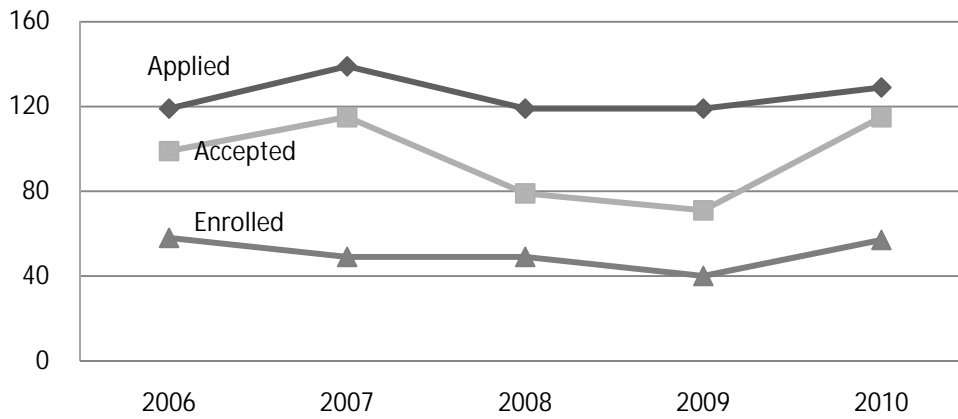

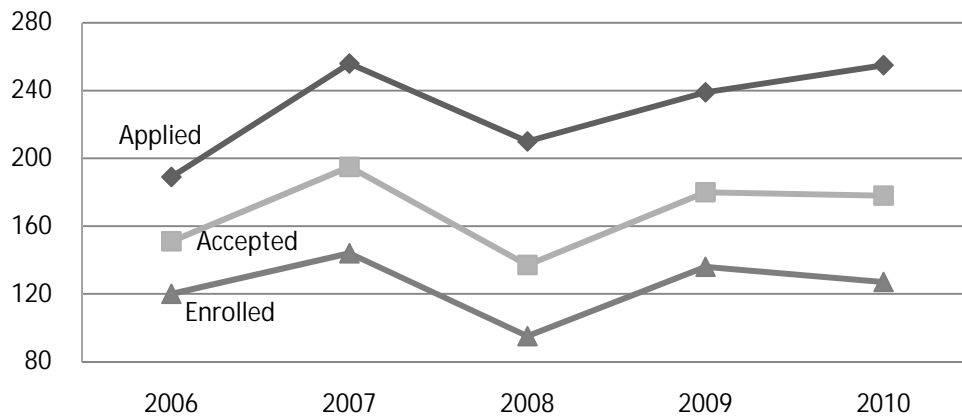

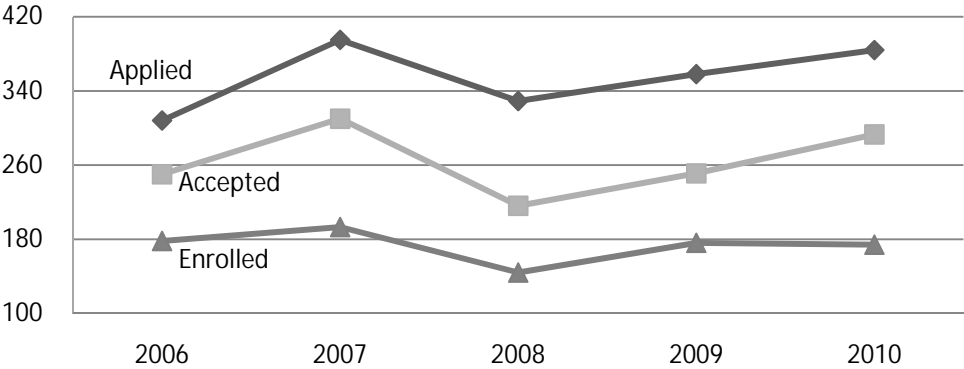
SGPP Transfers Applied, Accepted, Enrolled Fall 2006 to Fall 2010

Fall 2006 to Fall 2010



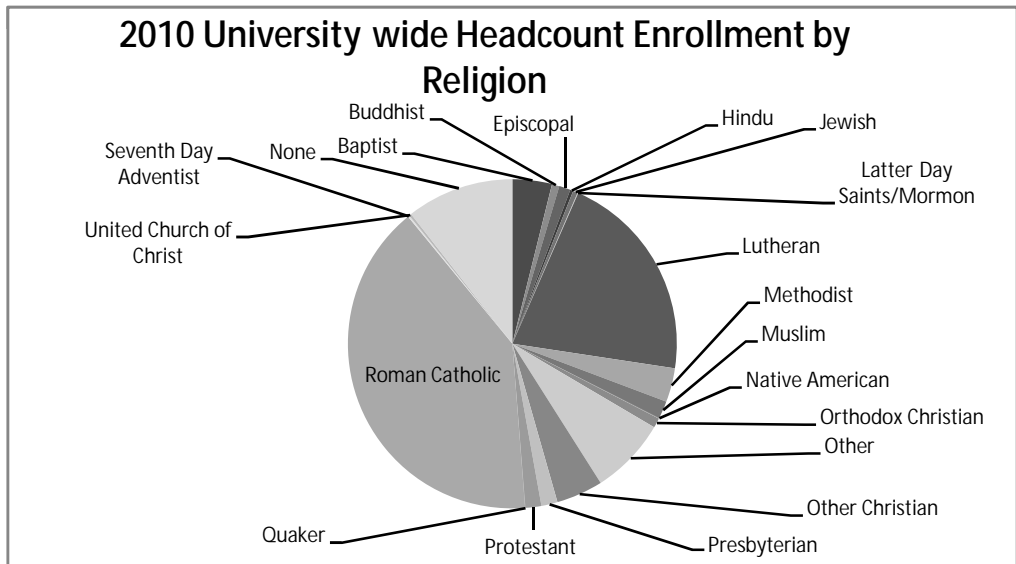

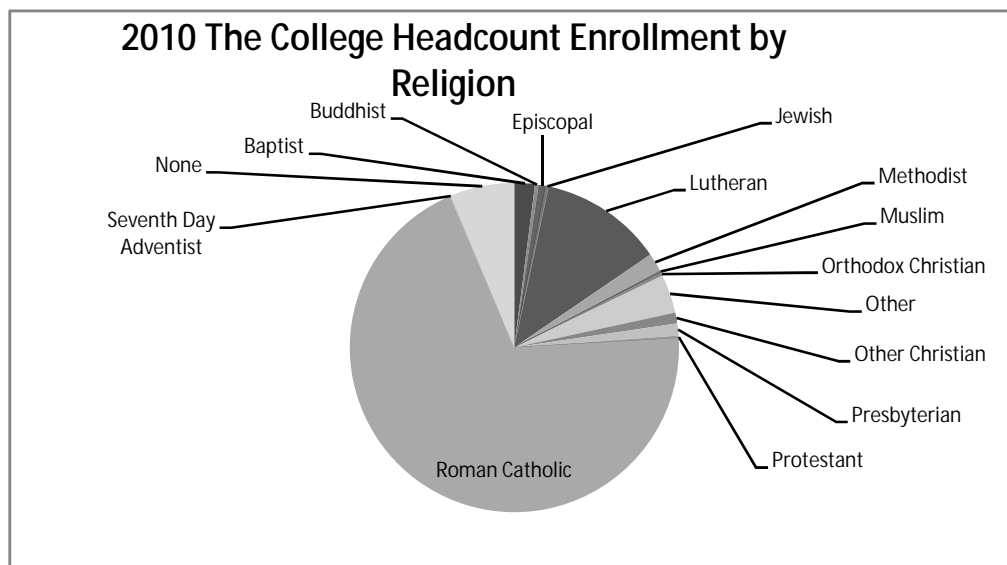

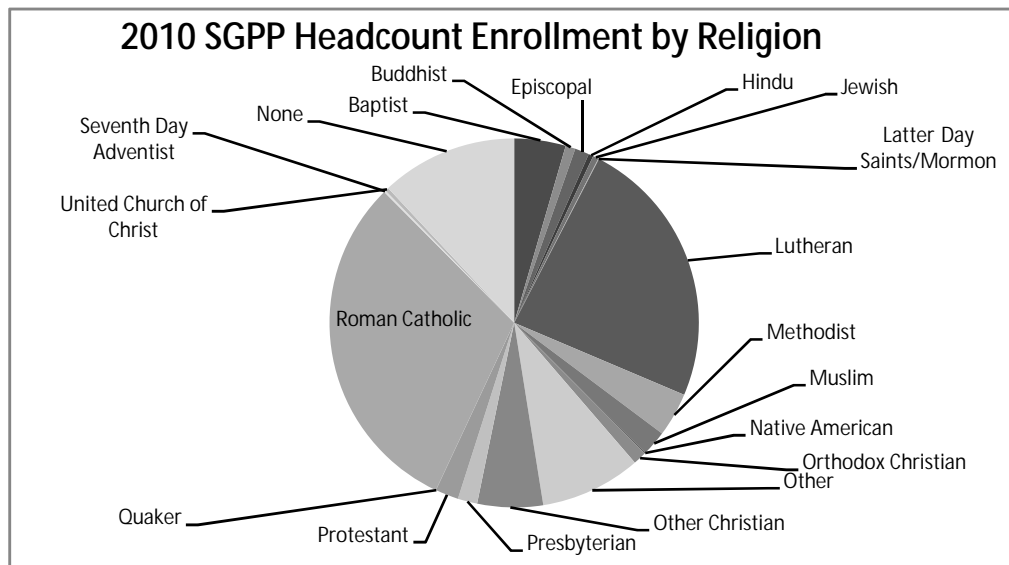

Student Profile Chart 18. SGPP Headcount Enrollment by Religion

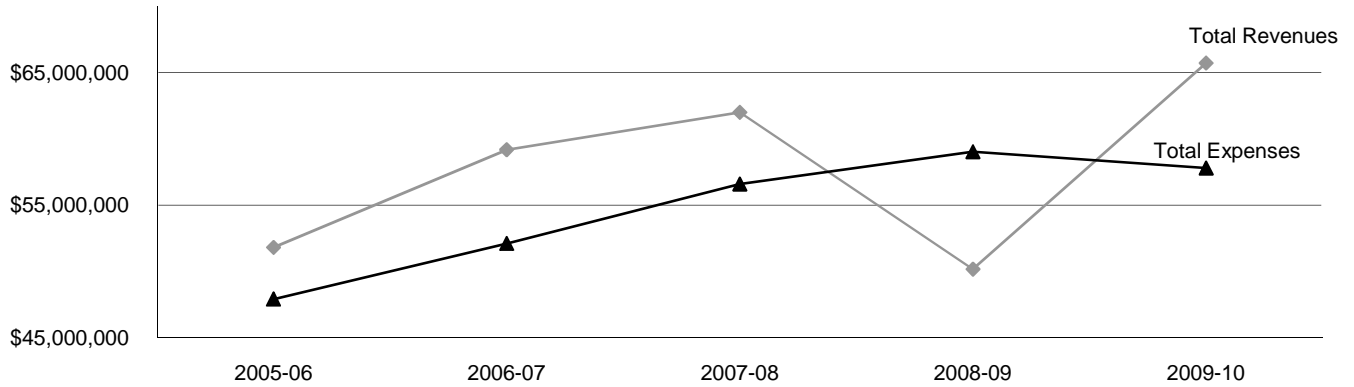

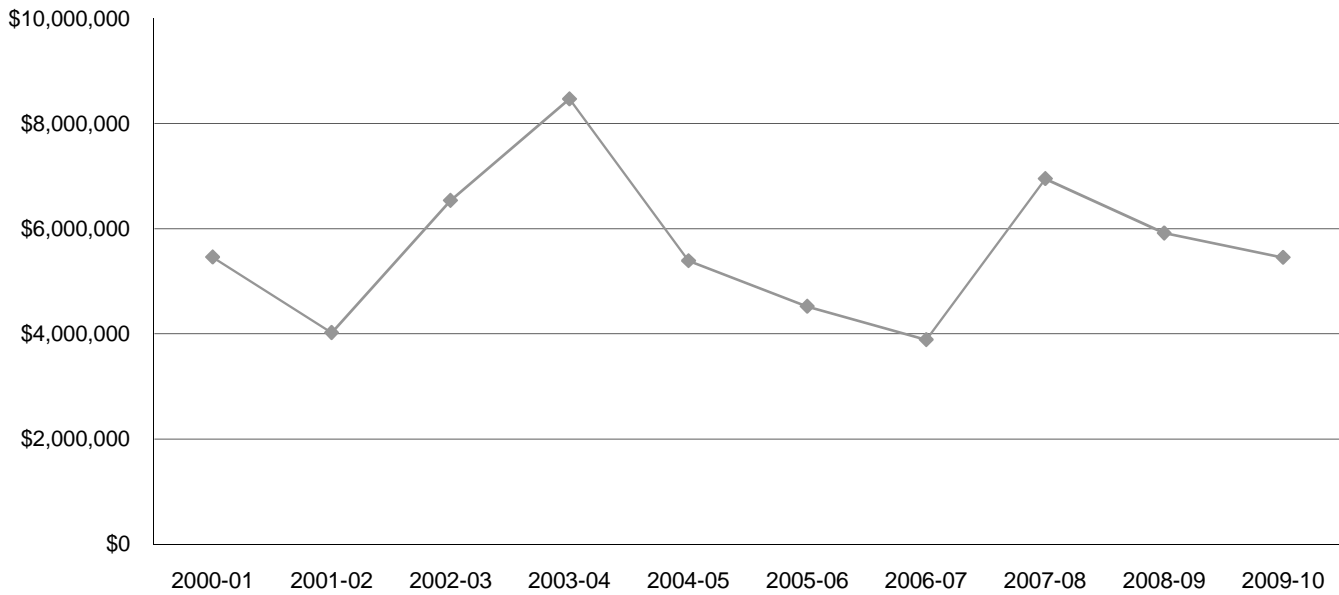

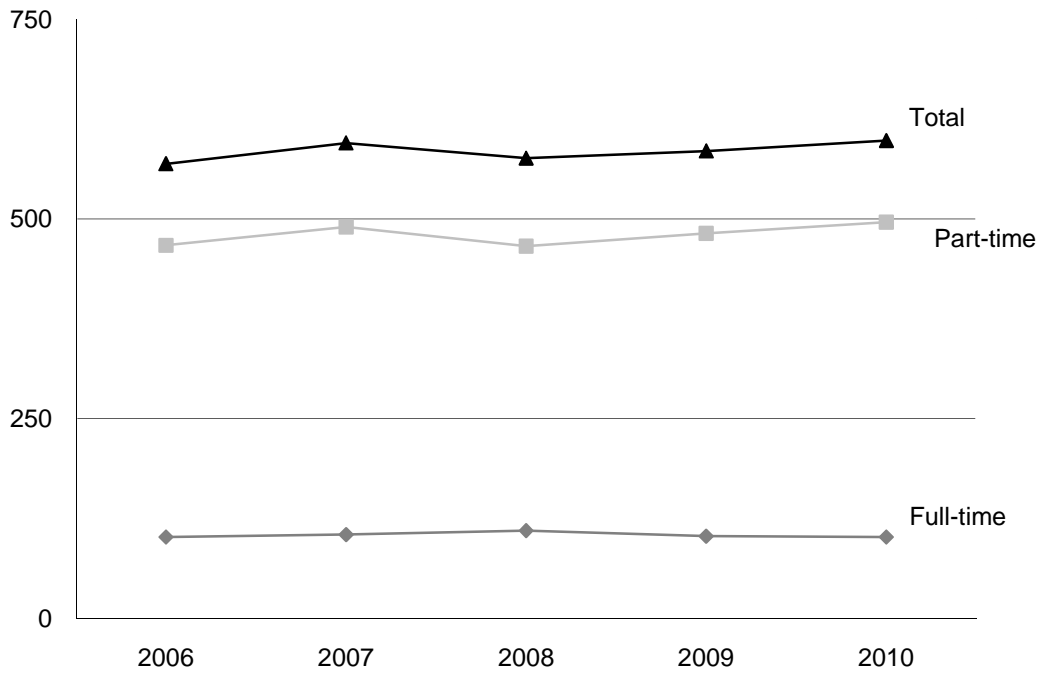

Faculty Headcount Fall 2006 to Fall 2010



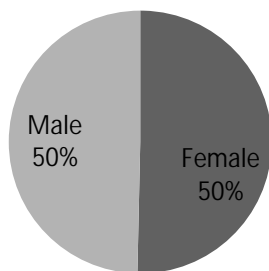

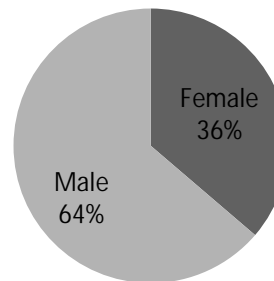

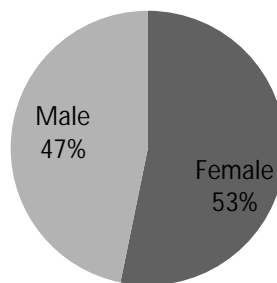
**Total Faculty by Gender

Fall 2010**



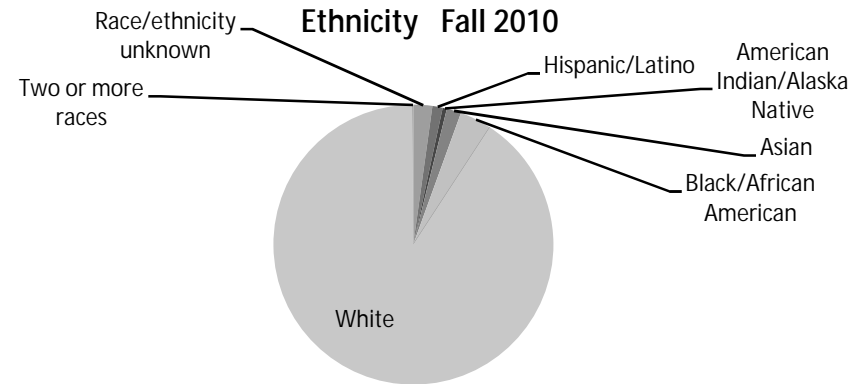
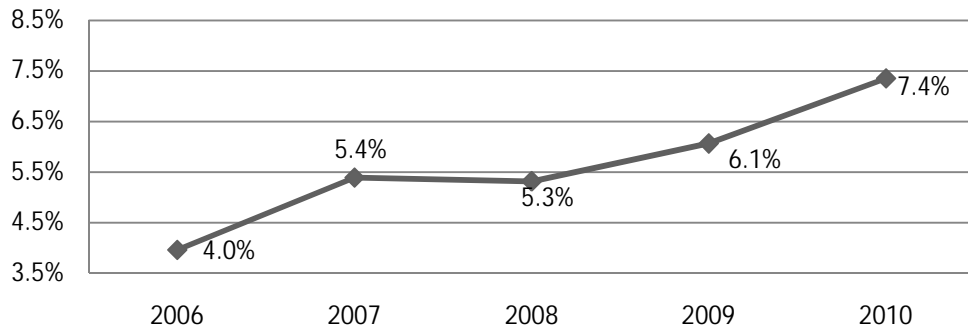

Staff Headcount Fall 2007 to Fall 2010



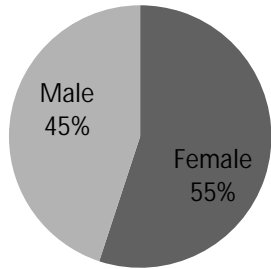

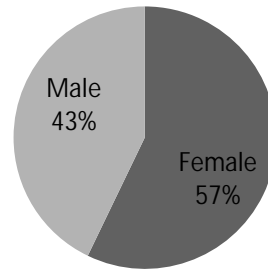

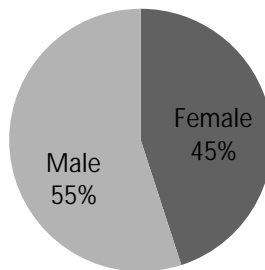
**Total Staff by Gender

Fall 2010**



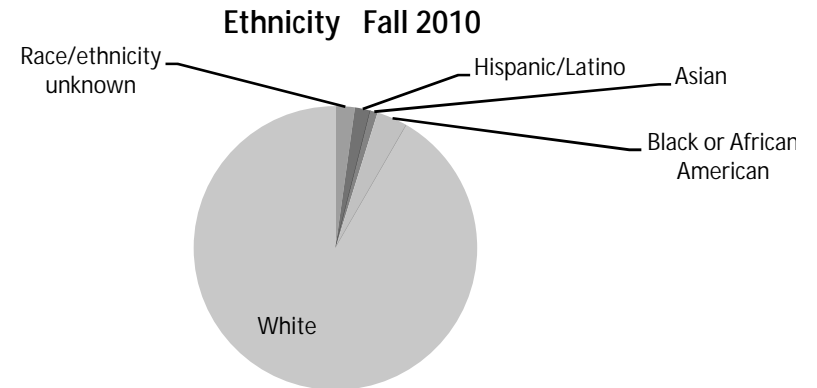
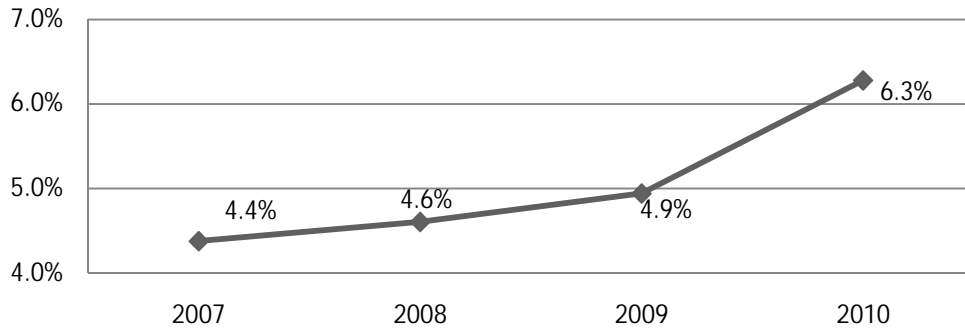

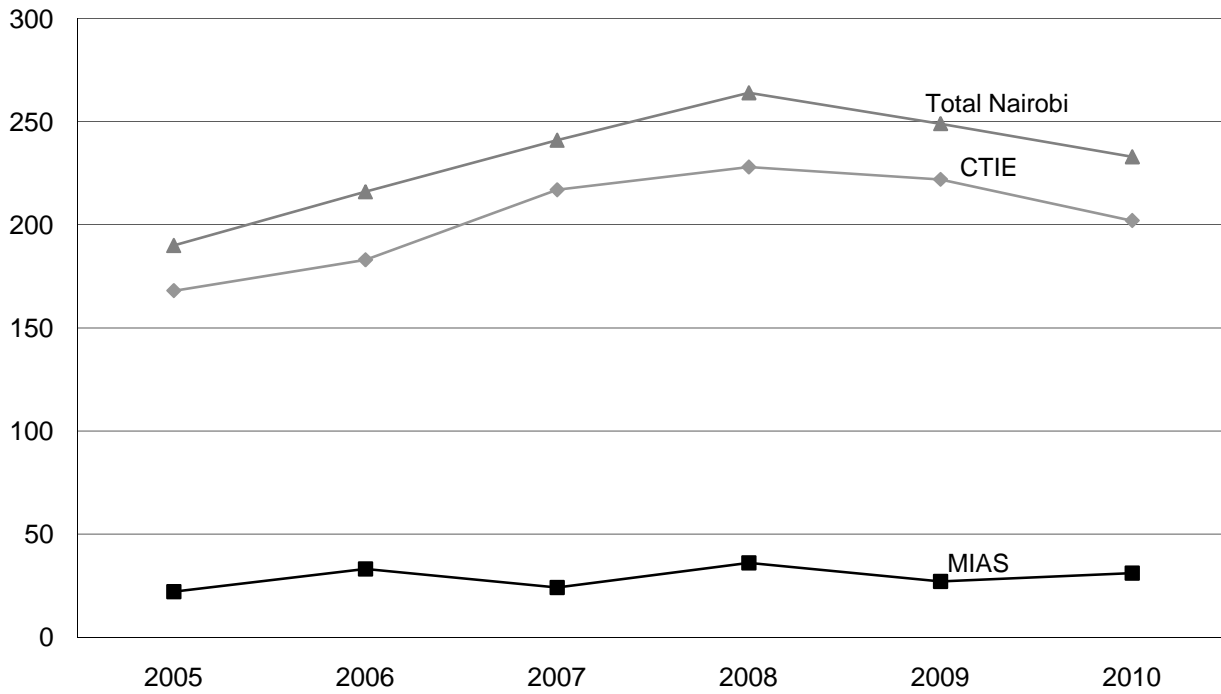

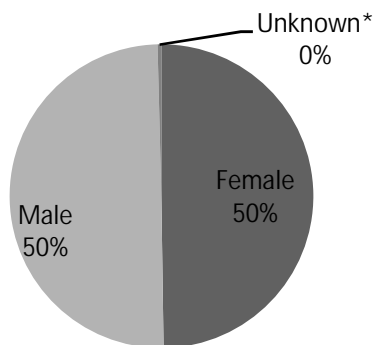

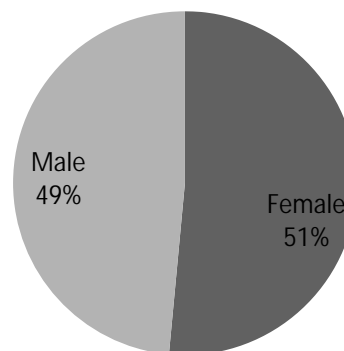

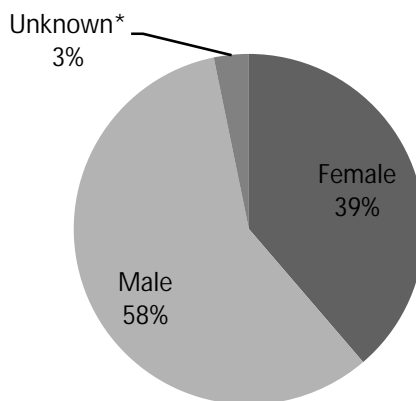
Nairobi Programs Total Enrollment by Gender Fall 2010



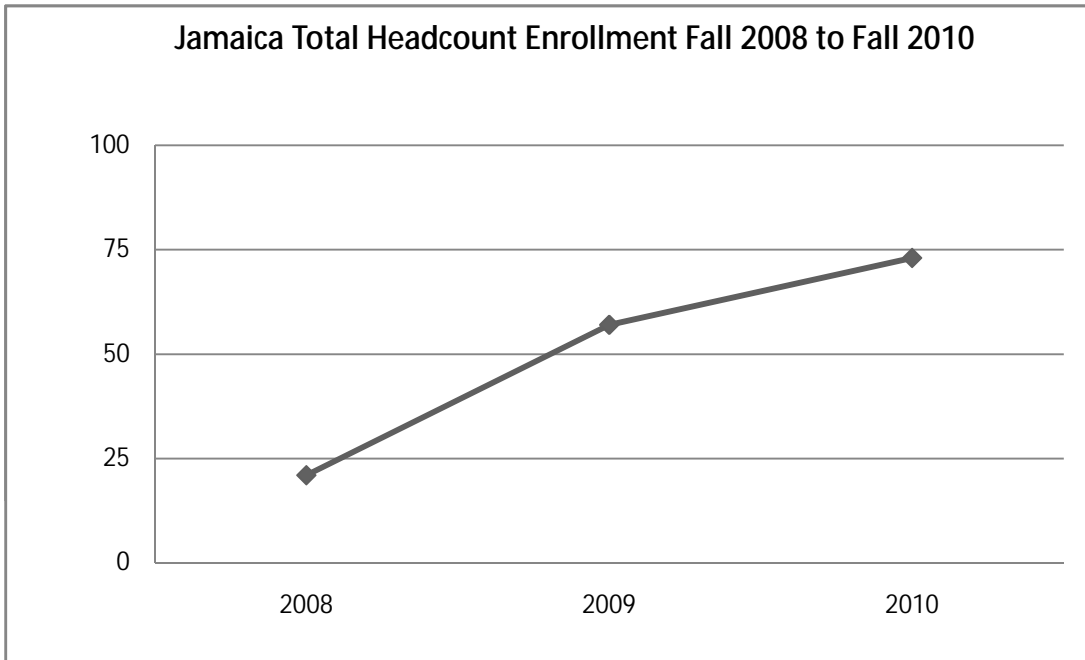
CTIE Enrollment by Gender Fall 2010
