The most recent four-year, five-year and six-year graduation rates, italicized and highlighted in yellow, may increase as students continue to bring in transfer credits to complete their degrees.

Included are first-time, first-year, full-time Winona campus bachelor degree-seeking students only.

The graduation rates are based on a year from September 1 to August 31.

The graduation and retention rate calculation for students entering in 2006 and 2010 each had one allowable cohort exclusion. Students may be excluded from the cohort for the following reasons: death, permanent disability, service in the armed forces, foreign aid service of the federal government, or official church missions.

In 2000, the university changed to a new student database system, therefore, the full-time degree seeking student counts prior to fall 2000 were taken from historical reports from the registrar's office.
